- PTF will appoint the required number of International Referees/Umpires. **Referees who are interested in officiating for this event must apply through EEY314@GMAIL.COM by FEBRUARY 28, 2026.**

- Round-trip Airfare shall be borne by each participating International Referee.

- The Organizing Committee shall cover four (4) nights of room and board expenses (check-in in early afternoon of July 9, 2026; checkout before Noon of July 13, 2026).

- Please note: **Referee meeting will be held on July 10th.**

- The Organizing Committee shall provide each participating International Referee with honorarium of USD\$150.00 per day for two (2) days of competition.

COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY AND FEES (in USD):

All participants must satisfy the following requirements in order to participate. This is an "Open" event, open to all ages and belt levels, in all Taekwondo disciplines.

- *Competitors will compete at the age based on their birth year.*

- \$125 for first event. Extra \$50 for each additional event.

COACH ELIGIBILITY AND FEES (in USD):

- All Coaches must be at least 18 years of age.

- Poomsae/Tul and Sparring: Early & Regular registration fee before May 31, 2026 11:59pm KOREA Time.

Coach Fee \$100 before May 31, 2026

Coach Late Registration Fee \$150 After June 1 – July 1, 2026

On Site Coach Registration - \$200.

TEAM MANAGER & DOCTOR, TRAINER & THERAPIST:

- \$100 registration fee for the entire duration of the event before May 31, 2026 11:59pm Korea Time. Late Registration Fee \$150 from June - July 1, 2026. **Door registration is not available.**

COMPETITION REGULATIONS:

Current Olympic, ITF and KT Sparring and Kukkiwon Poomsae / ITF Tul Competition Rules will govern the 2026 World Taekwondo Championships. The Organizing Committee retains full authority to modify, amend, or enforce changes to the championship rules at any time without prior notice.

ENTRY FEES, TERMS & CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:

- All Registration for Athletes, Coaches, and Officials must be completed through the Professional Taekwondo Federation Registration System: www.protkd.org.
- Round trip airfares, ground transportation, and room and board expenses shall be borne by all participants.
- Professional Taekwondo Federation have a NO REFUND policy.
- **NO REFUNDS will be given for any reason after registration has been completed.**

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT PROCESS:

Athletes, Coaches and Team Officials must register for the event through www.protkd.org.

Please pay online during registration. Organizer accepts credit card payments ONLY. All online payments are subject to a **mandatory** credit card processing fee based on the total event registration due. Registration will **not be confirmed until payment is received**. **DO NOT** wait until the last minute to register/pay.

Failure to submit payment by the early or regular registration deadline **will** result in late registration fees with **no exceptions**.

BOARD BREAKING: All boards are provided at the tournament venue for fairness. Boards must be held by athlete's coach. NO Board Holder's Passes Will Be Given.

-DISTANCE BREAK - Winner will be the competitor who jumps the farthest while breaking one regulation sized demo board at the 1st or 2nd attempt without stepping on the foul line. A 2nd attempt will only be offered to competitors who step on the fault line or fail to break the board in the 1st attempt.

-HEIGHT BREAK – Winner will be the competitor who jumps the highest while breaking one regulation sized demo board at the 1st or 2nd attempt. A 2nd attempt will only be offered to competitors who fail to break the board in the 1st attempt.

WEAPONS COMPETITION RULES:

- Cut Off system: Maximum set up time in 1-minute, maximum time to compete the demonstration is 90 seconds. Music and assisted devices (such as chairs, tables, etc.) are not permitted.

VISA ENTRY:

- All participants are responsible for their own visa and airfare.
- **Invitation letters WILL NOT BE ISSUED TO REGISTRANTS WHO HAVE NOT SUBMITTED REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT ONLINE.**

Sparring Rules and Competition Format

Organizing committee has the right to change, modify the duration of rounds, divisions and make official decisions without prior notices.

HEAD OF THE TEAM / TECHNICAL MEETING:

PTF technical officials shall conduct the Head of Team & Technical meeting on Friday July 10, 2026. Head of the team meeting location and time will be announced prior to event date.

The PTF Technical Delegate and Organizing Committee have the rights to change, modify the duration of rounds, and combine divisions at the Head of Team meeting. The official drawing will be done automatically and posted on the Professional Taekwondo Federation Facebook pages.

OFFICIAL UNIFORMS:

All Sparring competitors must wear Olympic/ITF/KT approved white uniform (dobok) in good condition. Patches, embroidery, logos, team names, country names, athlete names, and stripes are permitted on uniforms. **NO TAPING IS ALLOWED ON ANY PART OF THE UNIFORM.**

COACHES ATTIRE: Absolutely no Taekwondo uniforms, shorts, barefoot, hats, or open toe shoes during coaching. No phone and hearing devices allowed on coach seats.

SPARRING EQUIPMENT:

All sparring competitors are responsible for supplying their own sparring equipment according to the divisions in which they compete. Color Belts Will Not Use KPNP systems.

All Black Belt Olympic Sparring athletes will be provided with *KPNP PSS chest protectors & E Headgear* at the event. However, *KPNP K1 electronic foot pads* are the responsibility of each athlete competing in the Black Belt Olympic Sparring division. Black Belt Olympic Sparring competitors must own KPNP Socks.

All sparring competitors must also bring their own gloves, arm guards, shin guards, groin protectors, head gears, chest guards (if applicable), and **clear mouth guards**. No eyeglasses or goggles—prescription or nonprescription—are permitted under any circumstances. Face shields are mandatory for competitors aged 14 and under.

Please Note: Organizer reserves the right to disallow any uniform or equipment if it is found to be offensive or degrading in any fashion.

Weight Change **before** JULY 1, 2026 must be made through by email with completed Weight Change Form
Change Request Form can be found at www.protkd.org.
Weight Change after JULY 1, 2026 must be made on-site.

COMPETITION RULES:

Olympic Sparring – Official Olympic Taekwondo Kyorugi rules.

Traditional Sparring (ITF) – Official International Taekwon-Do Federation Sparring rules apply.

Kombat Sparring (KT) – Official Kombat Taekwondo Minor & Major Rules apply.

The Organizing Committee retains full authority to modify, amend, or enforce changes to the championship rules at any time without prior notice.

SINGLE ELIMINATION SYSTEM:

Single Elimination rules will apply to all sparring divisions.

SPARRING COMPETITIONS:

(Ages 6-7, 8-9, 10-11), (Ages 12-14), (Ages 15-17), (Ages 18 - 30), (Ages 31 - 49), (Ages 50+)

WEIGH-IN:

Weigh-in for ALL sparring competitors will take place at designated weigh-in area **one (1) day prior** to the start of the respective weight category of competition. **PLEASE REFER TO EVENT SCHEDULE FOR WEIGH IN TIME / DATE.**

- All weigh-in competitors must present a form of government issued photo ID.
- At weigh-in, male competitors must wear a minimal of underpants and female competitors must wear a minimal of underpants & brassieres. **Under NO circumstances may an athlete weigh-in in the nude.**
- Each athlete shall have one (1) attempt to pass the weigh in. However, one (1) extra attempt is allowed for those athletes who did not qualify the first time. This extra attempt shall be done within the time limit of the official weigh-in hours on the same day.
- If an athlete wants to change weight at the time of registration, he/she may do so for a fee of \$50.00. Athlete may change weight for the same fee after their 1st weigh-in attempt. A test scale will be available outside of the weigh in rooms.
- Weight change fee must be paid in cash, US currency only.
- Competitors who fail to weigh in within the registered weight divisions will be disqualified unless weight change request is made during weigh in time.

Sparring Competitors **CANNOT** participate in more than one (1) weight category in the same age division.

Organizing committee has the right to change, modify and make official decisions without prior notices.

HEAD OF THE TEAM / TECHNICAL MEETING:

OC shall conduct the Head of Team & Technical meeting on Friday, July 10, 2026. The PTF Technical Delegate and Organizing Committee have the rights to change, modify competition format and combine divisions at the Head of Team meeting.

OFFICIAL UNIFORMS: Olympic & ITF style V or Y-neck Taekwondo uniforms are mandatory for all competitors in all Poomsae/Tul divisions.

COACHES ATTIRE: Absolutely no Taekwondo uniforms, shorts, barefoot, hats, or open toe shoes during coaching. No phone and hearing devices allowed on coach seats.

OFFICIAL POOMSAE/TUL EVENTS:

World Taekwondo Poomsae

- Individual
- Pairs (2 people – Mixed Gender, Age & Belt Ranks Allowed)
- Team (3 people – Mixed Gender, Age & Belt Ranks Allowed)

International Taekwon-Do Tul

- Individual
- Pairs (2 people – Mixed Gender, Age & Belt Rank Allowed)
- Team (3 people – Mixed Gender, Age & Belt Rank Allowed)

Creative Team Poomsae

- Team of 3-5 people – Mixed Gender, Age & Belt Rank Allowed

Demo Team Competition

- Team of 7-12 people – Mixed Gender, Age & Belt Rank Allowed

POOMSAE / TUL COMPETITIONS:

Cut-Off system will be used in the Preliminary and semi-final rounds of all recognize Poomsae / Tul divisions.

COMPETITION RULES:

Competitors will perform Designated Poomsae / Tul. Please visit www.PROTKD.org for Designated Poomsae/Tul.

Kukkiwon Poomsae – Official Poomsae rules apply

ITF Tul – Official ITF rules apply.

Traditional Poomsae – Organizing Committee rules apply.

CUT OFF SYSTEM:

Cut off system rules will be used for all Poomsae / Tul divisions. Please visit www.PROTKD.org for Designated Poomsae/Tul.

Demo Team Rules

Organizing committee has the right to change, modify and make official decisions without prior notices.

OFFICIAL UNIFORMS:

All Demo Team competitors must wear Olympic/ITF/PTF approved white uniform (dobok) in good condition. Patches, embroidery, logos, team names, country names, athlete names, and stripes are permitted on uniforms. **NO TAPING IS ALLOWED ON ANY PART OF THE UNIFORM. NO KNEE / ELBOW PADS.**

DEMONSTRATION TEAM COMPETITION:

- Maximum time to complete the demonstration is 8 minutes including set-up and clean-up time.
- The routine shall be done within at least 8mx8m area.
- Minimum of 7 members and no more than 12 members. All Demo Teams must be self-sufficient for Board breaking part of their Demo routine. No coach, master or outside board holders are allowed. Boards must be held by demo team members.
- Music and reproductive system must be provided by the demonstration team. **Teams without music will be disqualified.**
- No pyrotechnics, fireworks or rockets.
- Boards, weapons, official tables or other accessories shall be provided by the demonstration team.
- All Demo performances must include, Poomsae / Tul, Self-defense, and board breaking routine. Additional routines are encouraged.
- Additional presentation points will be awarded for weapons demonstration.

DEMO TEAM SCORING:

Based on the following order of superiority in ascending order:

1. Synchronization technique (20%).
2. Excitement on the performance (20%).
3. Successful completion of Taekwondo techniques (20%).
4. Entertainment generated (20%).
5. Display of Precision, Speed and Power (20%).

Major Deduction (0.5 points):

- Any part of the body above the ankle bone that touch the mats.
- Crossing the boundary line with both feet.
- Under or Over time
- Inability to complete all four (4) mandatory skills.
- Assistance from team members in completing aerial techniques.
- Extreme remarkable and offensive behavior amongst coaches and competitors; failure to obey directions from referees / officials.

Minor Deduction (0.1 points):

- Failure to break boards or execute board breaking techniques.
- Losing balance, extended pause, lack of synchronization and harmony.
